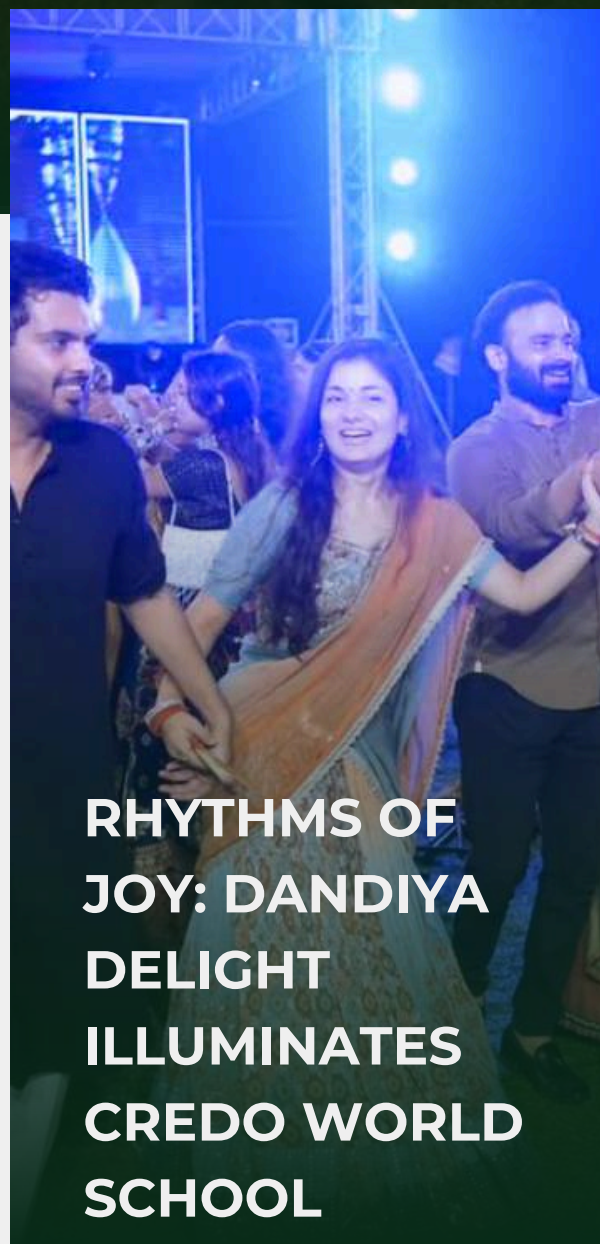
DANDIYA DELIGHT

At the 2nd Jharkhand State Inter-School Swimming Championship, held in Dhanbad, the school's swimmers showcased superlative skills and unflagging loyalty to both their sport and institution. * **Harnessing Positive Tension:** Participants explored how "Good Stress" can act as a powerful catalyst. When managed correctly, this form of pressure sharpens focus and provides the necessary drive to achieve ambitious goals and meet deadlines with precision.

* **Combatting Negative Impact:** A substantial portion of the session was dedicated to identifying and mitigating "Bad Stress." The resource persons shared effective strategies to avoid the burnout and physical exhaustion typically associated with prolonged exposure to negative pressures.

As the session concluded, the faculty left with more than just theoretical knowledge. They walked away with a renewed perspective on their roles, understanding that mental wellbeing is the cornerstone of effective teaching. This CBP training stands as a testament to the school's commitment to nurturing a healthy, balanced, and motivated teaching community.
